<b>A</b>	Vessel name and Voyage number
<b>B</b>	Port of loading
<b>C</b>	Port of Discharge and final port of destination
<b>D</b>	Booking reference number
<b>E</b>	Number and kind of package (innerpacking if needed)
<b>F</b>	Amount, type and size of containers, if available
<b>G</b>	Proper shipping name of substance of substance, (as listed in the current ed. of the IMDG Code) including chemical name for NOS entries. Tradenames may be used in addition only
<b>H</b>	Quantity: Net weight in kilos or pounds (or contents in liters where applicable)
<b>I</b>	Flashpoint, if 61 C° or below
<b>J</b>	Classification: IMDG code Class and UN number, and or national requirement where applicable
<b>K</b>	EMS-N° and MFAG Table-N° where applicable or required
<b>L</b>	Additional properties
<b>M</b>	Further details: special permits, test or weathering certificates, for explosive also net powder weight, caliber , etc.
<b>N</b>	Marine pollutant, if applicable advise chemical name
<b>O</b>	Packaging group
<b>P</b>	Emergency telephone number
<b>Q</b>	Solid or liquid (only in cases where is not apparent form above details)
<b>R</b>	Liable to evolve flammable gases or vapors (only in cases where is not apparent form above details)
<b>S</b>	Transit and / or discharge permission granted (where required for certain articles only)
<b>T</b>	Containers under fumigation ( where required for certain articles only)

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
